OFTEC OFT 102D (Dry) Vapourising Appliance Commission & Service

(Required for engineers working with (dry) vapourising-burner appliances and wishing to register with OFTEC to self-certify notifiable commissioning works under the Building Regulations).

1 day 'Guide to the Assessment' plus 1 day assessment.

The guide to the assessment includes information on the general commissioning and service requirements of oil-fired, (dry) vapourising-burner appliances including:

- Health and Safety Regulations, Documents, & Standards
- Flues and Ventilation
- Basic Oil Storage Requirements and Oil Supply
- Upgrade of Existing Systems
- Oil Combustion and Burner Operation
- Servicing of (dry) Vapourising Burners and Appliances
- Commissioning of (dry) Vapourising Burners and Appliances

(Note: Vapourising central-heating appliances are **not** covered in this qualification unless taken as part of a package with OFTEC 101 or 105E

The 'guide' comprises of both classroom and practical work.

Please note that the 'Guide to the Assessment' is designed to refresh and update knowledge already possessed by the candidate and should **not** be viewed as an in-depth training course for candidates new to the industry. New entrants into oil-firing work are strongly advised to consider undertaking the OFTEC 50 (Introduction to Oil-Firing).

The assessment consists of a number of multi-choice-answer question papers (which are 'open-book') and observed practical tasks as designated by the assessor.

Pre-requisites for this course would ideally be previous experience and knowledge of the servicing and/or commissioning of oil-fired appliances or the successful completion of the OFTEC 50 (Introduction to Oil-Firing) course.
