### OFTEC Domestic Oil-Firing Training and Assessments

#### OFTEC Combined 105E/101/102 (W & D see note below)

(Required for engineers wishing to register with OFTEC to self-certify notifiable works under the Building Regulations).

2½ day 'Guide to the Assessment' plus 2 day assessment.

The guide to the assessment includes information on the general installation, commissioning and service requirements of oil-fired appliances including:

- Health and Safety Regulations, Documents, & Standards
- Flues and Ventilation
- Basic Oil Storage Requirements and Oil Supply
- Appliance & System Installation
- Inspection and Upgrade of Existing Systems
- Selection of Appliances & Equipment
- Energy Efficiency Measures
- Oil Combustion and Burner Operation (Pressure-Jet and Vapourising)
- Servicing of Pressure-Jet and Vapourising Burners and Appliances.
- Commissioning of Pressure-Jet and Vapourising Burners and Appliances

**(Note:** The OFT102 is divided into Wet(W - central-heating appliances) and Dry (D – Non-central heating appliances)

Please note, also, that the 'Guide to the Assessment' is designed to refresh and update knowledge already possessed by the candidate and should **not** be viewed as an in-depth training course for candidates new to the industry. New entrants into oil-firing work are strongly advised to consider undertaking the OFTEC 50 (Introduction to Oil-Firing).

The assessment consists of a number of multi-choice-answer question papers which are 'open-book' accompanied by observed practical tasks.

**Pre-requisites for this course would ideally be previous experience and knowledge of the installation, commissioning, and servicing of oil-fired pressure-jet and vapourising appliances, or the successful completion of the OFTEC 50 (Introduction to Oil-Firing) course.**
